Methods

Write a class named **Methods** and in **main** do the following:

- 1. Write a method named **sayHi** that when called prints to the console the string "Hello". Call the method from main.
- 2. Write a method named **doubleInt** that has a single parameter that holds an integer. The method returns a value that is twice the value that was passed into the method. In main, ask the user for an integer, call the method passing it the value that was entered by the user, and print the value returned from the method.
- 3. Write a method named **difference** that has two integer parameters. The method returns the difference of the two integers passed into the method. In main, ask the user for two integers, call the method passing it the values that were entered by the user, and print the value returned from the method.
- 4. Write a method named **max** that has two integer parameters. The method returns the value of the larger argument passed into the method. In main, ask the user for two integers, call the method passing it the values that were entered by the user, and print the value returned from the method.
