In your **EntryTest** class, add a method named **printHexStringAsUnicodeChar**. The method takes a String as an argument. We'll assume the string holds the hexadecimal representation of a unicode character. The method converts the string to a unicode character and prints the character to the screen.

For example, if the string is "03b2", then the greek letter β (beta) is printed to the screen, since 03b2 is the hexadecimal value for the beta unicode character.

In main, for each Entry in the ArrayList, print to the screen the value associated with the entry as a unicode character.
