HOMEWORK 5 - CUSTOM CSS

- 1. Create a directory named **images** in our coursework directory.
- 2. Add an image (any image you like) to the **images** directory and upload it to your web server.
- 3. Add an HTML file named a5.html to your coursework directory.
- 4. Add a CSS file named **a5.css** to your CSS directory.
- 5. Add a html to load your a5.css file.
- 6. Add the following content to your **a5.html** file. When adding the content, give the content some structure by placing the content in <div>, <header>, <main>, <section>, , and <footer> elements.
 - 1. The image that now resides in your images directory.
 - 2. A haiku
 - 3. 3 web links
 - 4. A bit of lorem ipsum text
- 7. Give some of the HTML elements ids.
- 8. Give some of the HTML elements class names.
- 9. Study the tutorials that I link to in my lecture 5 demo. Do this before proceeding further.
- 10. Add CSS in your **a5.css** file, using different combinations of selectors and rules, to stylize your html page so that it looks **as ugly as possible**.

The goal of this assignment is to experiment with CSS selectors and to play around with the various properties of the HTML elements that can be modified using CSS.

The person with the ugliest web page (judged by the class on Friday) will automatically receive a grade of 100 for Homework 4 and this assignment.
