Part I

Note: In the instructions below, please make all subdirectory names lowercase and identical to names specified.

Somewhere on your laptop create a subdirectory named **csci230**. The **csci230** directory will be the base directory of your website.

Inside the csci230 directory create a file named index.html and a file named index.css.

Inside the csci230 directory create a subdirectory named experiments.

Inside the **experiments** directory create a *subdirectory* named **e1**.

Inside the e1 directory create a file named e1.html and a file named e1.css.

Part II

In **csci230/index.html** and **csci230/index.css** add HTML and CSS (respectively) to do the following:

- ·Display your name.
- •Include a heading for a *list* of links to the experiments you perform this semester.
- •Create a list and include in the list a link to csci230/experiments/e1/e1.html.

Part III

In e1.html write a web page that satisfies the following.

Note #1: you are encouraged to go beyond the requirements below and experiment with HTML and CSS.

Note #2: Anyone that uses my likeness in any of their experiments in this class will receive a F in the class.

- All styling must occur in e1.css.
- The background of the page must be red.
- Add multiple elements that have different colors, sizes, and shapes to the page so that they completely fill the page and so that you cannot see any of the red background color.
- Each of the elements added to the page are constrained as follows:
 - each must not have a width or height that exceeds 1/4 of the page.
 - each must overlap at least two other shapes.
- At least one shape must have a visible border.
- At least one shape must have noticeable padding.
